Quick explanations and official links for frequently used forms.

Form W-9

Used to request a payee's name and taxpayer identification number.

Form W-4

Used by employees to provide withholding information to an employer.

Forms 1099-NEC / 1099-MISC

Businesses may have information-reporting obligations for certain payments. The exact requirement depends on the payment and recipient.

Estimated Tax

Individuals and businesses may need estimated payments when withholding is insufficient.

Current Forms

Use the current-year forms and instructions published by IRS.gov.

Colorado Forms

Use Colorado Department of Revenue for current state forms, instructions and sales-tax resources.
